Change of Contact Details and Medical Information

Please remember to update us if there are any changes to your contact details, it is important we are able to contact you in an emergency. Please also let us know if your child has any new or changed medical conditions including any allergies or food intolerances. We have included a form at the end of this newsletter which you can use to report any changes if required.

Lunches

Thank you to everyone who sent in a lunch order form for the remainder of this term. If you didn't send one in but your child usually has school meals we have ordered meals based on the last term's form. If you would like to change this then please complete a new form. Milk

COVID Testing Pilot

We are taking part in a pilot programme to offer COVID-19 testing to children who are attending school and develop some of the wider symptoms of COVID-19. It is known that there are sometimes wider symptoms associated with COVID-19 and in children these symptoms can present instead of or in advance of the classic symptoms.

Wider symptoms in this pilot are:

Loss of Appetite Sore Throat Extreme Tiredness Nausea

Headaches

Diarrhoea (must be clear of symptoms for 48hrs before returning to school)

Joint Pain or Muscle Ache

Vomiting (must be clear of symptoms for 48hrs before returning to school)

Worcestershire County Council's Public Health team want to ensure they are doing all they can to prevent any further COVID-19 cases. Therefore, they are recommending:

- That all children in our school or nursery get a COVID-19 PCR test if they display any of the less common/wider symptoms which are new to them (see list above).
- If any of these wider symptoms are normal for your child as a result of other conditions (eg allergies, hay fever, migraine etc) then we suggest your child is not tested.
- Children should not be tested regularly if symptoms last a few days or a week, testing should only be at the onset of the new symptom(s).
